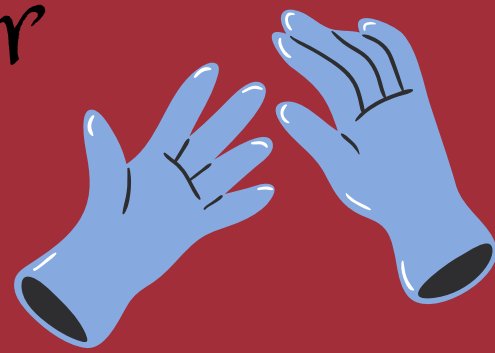
Some 70 students participated with eagerness. The enthusiasm of the students in the testing times was commended by the entire NSS cell and all participants were certified without giving ranks.

How will the Eastern coast of India rebuild from the twin challenges of COVID-19 and Amphan cyclone.

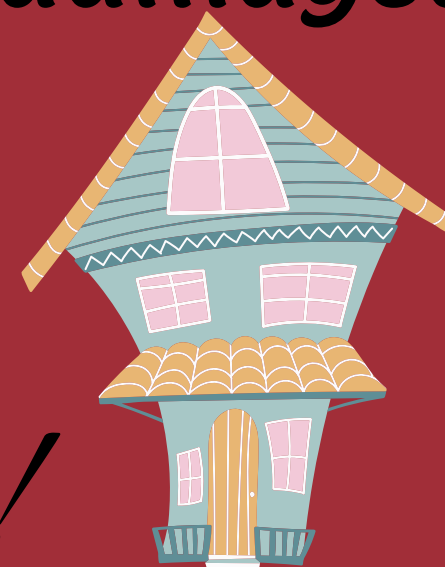

The airport was left flooded and severely damaged.



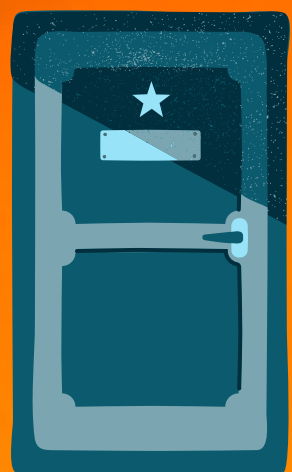
Thatched houses were all but blown away, low-lying towns and villages were swamped.

Authorities began clearing roads and assessing damage after Cyclone Amphan barreled through coastal communities in eastern India

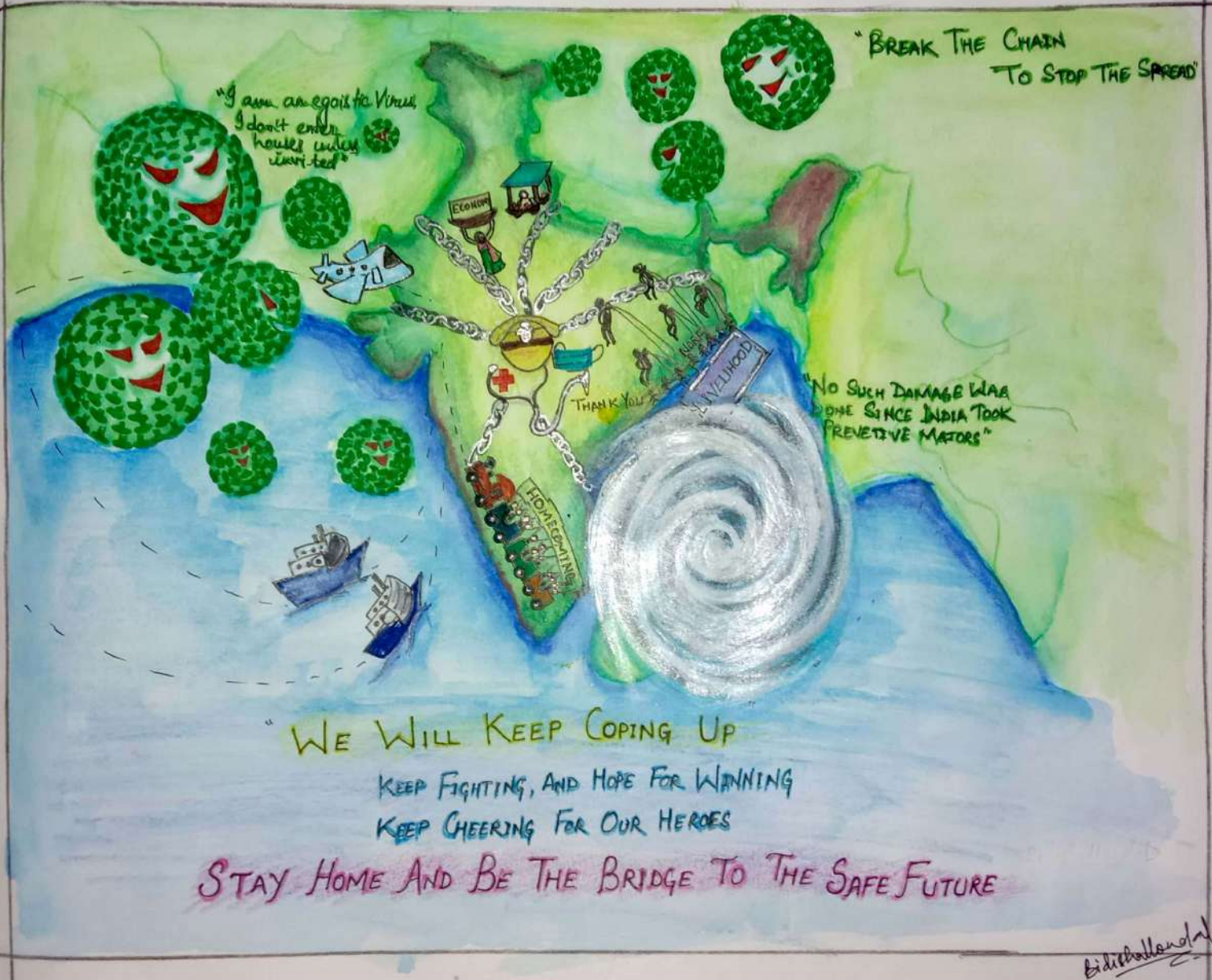
Amphan cyclone
