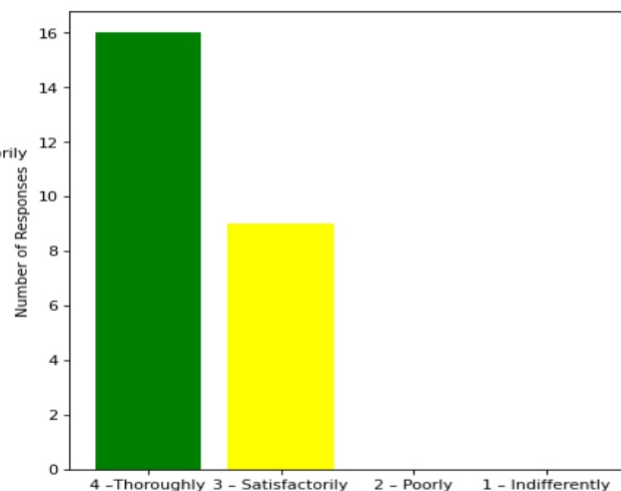
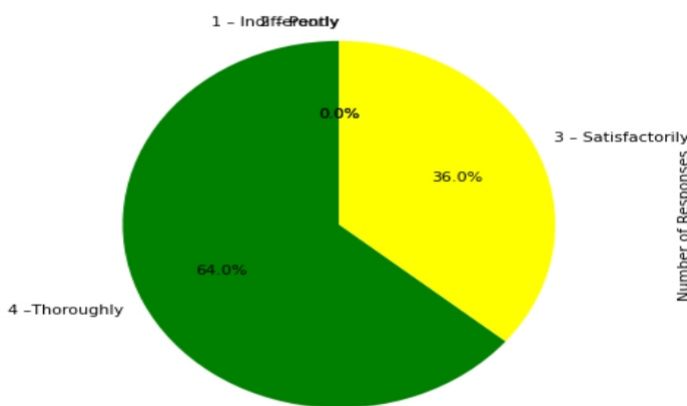
### 1. The overall syllabus coverage in the class is to an extent of
