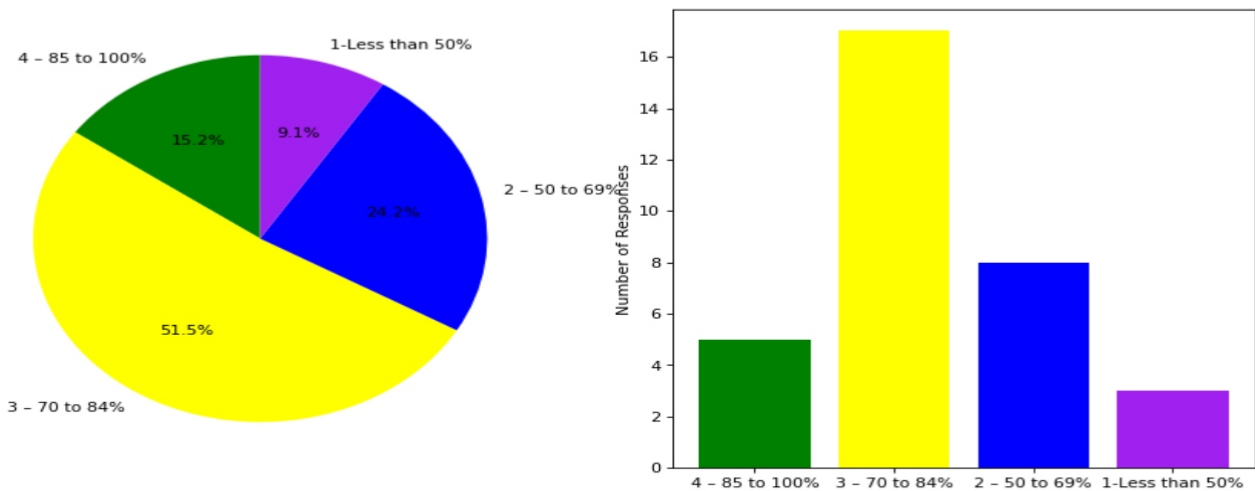

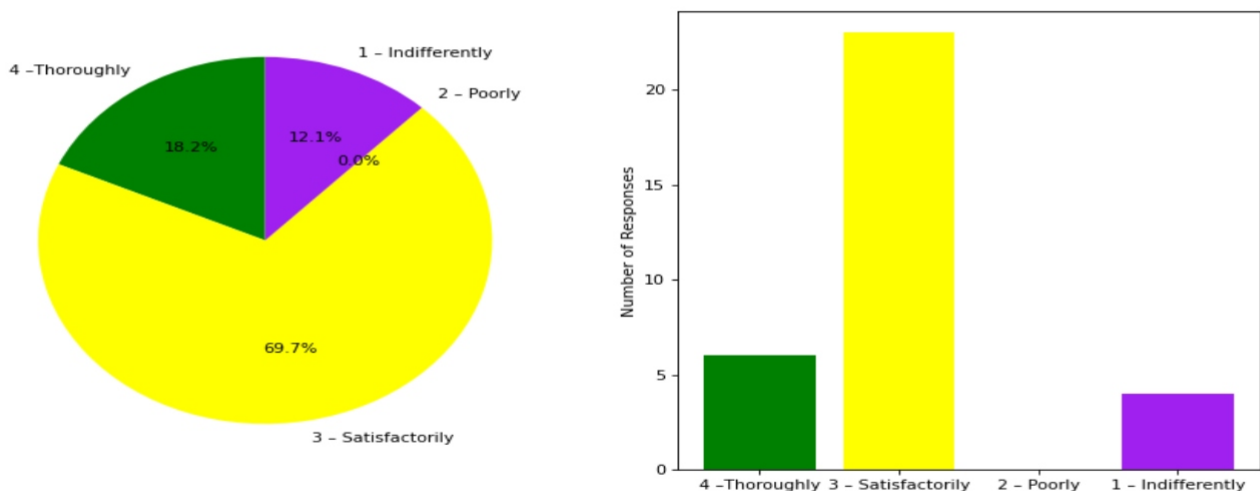
#### 1. The overall syllabus coverage in the class is to an extent of

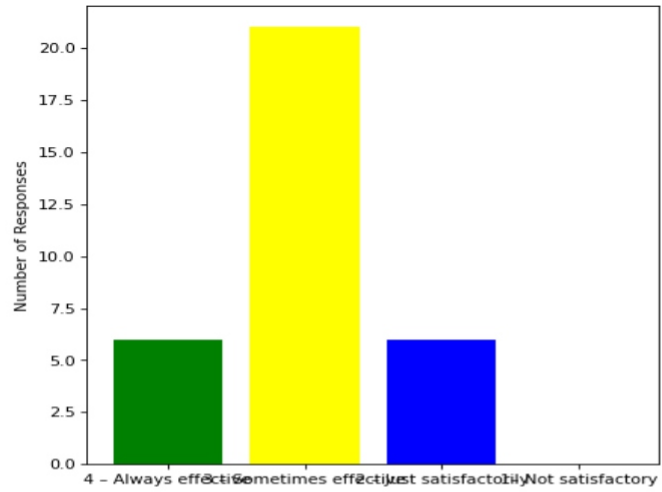
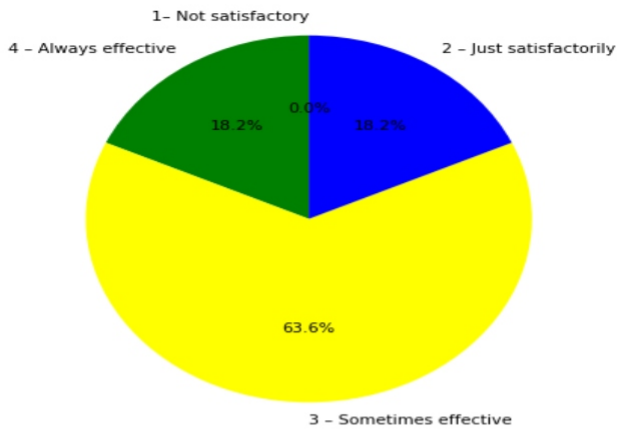
#### 2. Teachers are prepared for the classes

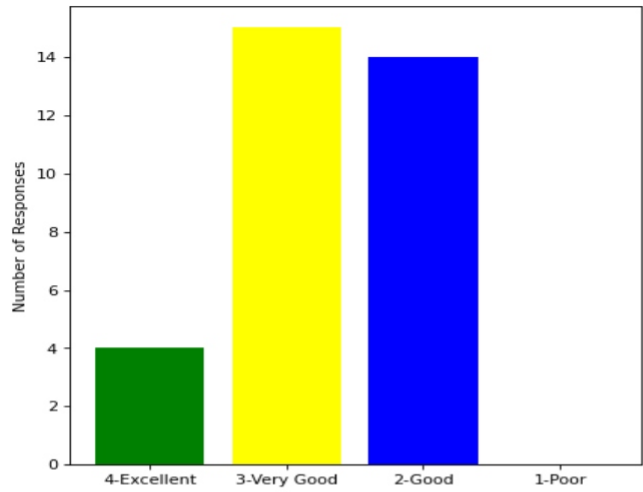
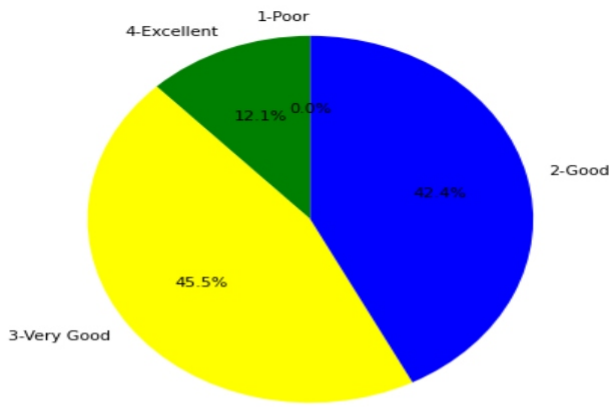
### 13. Class room facility
