REPORT OF WEBINAR ON "THE APPLICATION OF ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE IN BANKING IN INDIA"

Date: Saturday, 9th April, 2022

A webinar on "The application of artificial intelligence in banking in India" was organised by the Faculty of Management Studies, Dr B C Roy Engineering College, Durgapur, through online mode on Thursday, 9th April 2022.

The webinar started with a brief introduction about the event by FMS student anchor and a formal introduction of the resource person by Prof. Dr. Somroop Siddhanta, HOD, FMS. Dr. Siddhanta spoke about the importance of the financial system in developing an economy, accentuating the role of banking in the financial system.

The session was then handed over to the honourable speaker who carried on with the rest of the session.

Mr. Das started by giving a brief overview of the State Bank of India highlighting the key financial aspects of the bank. He emphasized on the significant transformation of the banking industry in India by moving from the traditional to a digital world. He added that digital transformation has revolutionised day to day banking operations for consumers, has 24x7 access to banking services, improves process efficiency and reduces human error. He further added that though the banking industry has undergone significant changes in the last few years with digital transformation, it has come across different challenges and threats concerning security concerns and competition with non-financial institutions.

The next part of his deliberation was about how the banking industry transformed by using technology, specifically artificial intelligence. Mr. Das explained that the most commonly used AI technologies are robotic process automation, virtual assistant, personalized money-management interfaces and other machine learning techniques. In this context, he spoke about one of the most effective technological solutions for the bank: chatbots. He discussed the importance of chatbots in enhancing productivity and preventing customers from waiting to receive responses.

At the end of the session, there was a question and answer round where the students were encouraged to ask questions. Overall the session was very promising, interesting, informative and interactive. The webinar ended with a vote of thanks by the host. It was attended by around 63 participants including head and faculty members of FMS, Dr B. C. Roy Engineering College.
