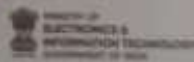

Subject: Release of Grant in Aid to **Dr. B. C. Roy Engineering College, Durgapur, West Bengal** under Grant-in-Aid Head “**603.4 – Smart India Hackathon 2022 Software Edition**” for hosting Smart India Hackathon Software Edition-2022

Sir,

This is to convey the sanction of the Council for payment of **Rs 6,72,000/- (INR Rupees Six Lakh Seventy-Two Thousand Only)** as Grant-in-Aid to **Dr. B. C. Roy Engineering College, Durgapur, West Bengal** through RTGS/NEFT towards the expenditure to be incurred from Head “**603.4 – Smart India Hackathon 2022 Software Edition**” in hosting Smart India Hackathon Software Edition-2022 to be held from 25th -26th August, 2022.

The amount of the Grant shall be drawn by the Drawing and Disbursing Officer, All India Council for Technical Education from MoE's Innovation cell account on the Grant-in-Aid bill and shall be disbursed to and credited to the account of Director/Principal/ Registrar of the Institute through RTGS/NEFT.

The instructions/guidelines to be followed by Nodal Centers for utilizing the above Grant-in-Aid during SIH-Software Edition-2022 is as follows:

- A. Each team has certain team members (hereafter referred as Participants), mentors (mentors may be professor's/industry experts). Each Nodal Centre would have a few Design Mentors who would guide the students on designing a market ready product during the 5 days long hackathon (hereafter referred as Design Mentors). Nodal Centre heads during SIH would be MIC/AICTE officials or appointed by Council.
- B. This Grant-in-Aid sanctioned to the Nodal Centres will be utilised under the following heads:

I. Student teams & mentors Travelling expenses:

- ✓ The maximum ceiling of travel reimbursement is fixed up to Rs 2,000/- per person (Subject to actuals) by the Council for their round trip including local mileage (@11 Rs/KM), if any based on production the actual bills.
- ✓ Each member of the team will be provided reimbursement for Sleeper class train fare for the shortest route. If the person travels in other mode of transportation, an amount equivalent to travel fare of Sleeper class Train Tickets will be reimbursed with a maximum ceiling of Rs 2,000/- only.
- ✓ If the train connectivity is not available in a particular sector and the journey is performed by road, then the reimbursement will be made of public transport mode with an upper ceiling of Rs 2,000/- only subject to actuals, based on producing the relevant bills/tickets of the state transport services.
- ✓ However, the reimbursement of TA will only be given by filling the enclosed TA form of the Council which contains the journey details, signed by the team leader and verified by the Nodal Centres along with the documentary proof.

II. Juries/evaluators/experts Travel expenses:

- ✓ All the travel expenses and arrangements of the Juries/evaluators/experts **appointed by the MIC/AICTE** have been taken care by the MIC/AICTE itself. Nodal centre have to collect the enclosed TA/Honorarium form of the Council which contains the personal information along with the journey details signed by the Juries/evaluators/experts and verified by the Nodal Centres along with the documentary proof i.e. the bills/tickets of local taxi/Cab (Airport/Station/Bus Stand drop and pick up) and boarding passes of the inward and outward journey.
- ✓ No claim can be made against these expenses by the nodal centre. Nodal centre has to send these documents to AICTE/MIC with the utilization certificate and statement of expenditure, and the amount will be transferred directly to the evaluator's bank account post receiving the documents and satisfactory verification.
- ✓ However, no amount will be reimbursed/transferred to those evaluators, who have been appointed by the Nodal Centre.

III. Lodging/Boarding/Food for:

- ✓ **Participants & Mentors:** The stay and food arrangements of participants & mentors shall be provided by the Nodal Centre. Each team is eligible for maximum of 2 mentors. A maximum amount of Rs 1500/- per member only will be provided to Nodal Centre for the Stay and food arrangements for the entire event. The participants & mentors shall be allowed to stay only from **24th August early morning to 27th August Evening**.

- ✓ **Juries/evaluators/experts:** The stay and food arrangements of Juries/evaluators shall be provided by the Nodal Centre. Nodal Centres can make their stay and food arrangements either in their guest house or nearby hotels for which a ceiling of Rs 2,000/- per person/ per day will be provided to Nodal Centre. Nodal Centre should ensure the comfortable stay for Juries/evaluators/experts. The Juries/evaluators/experts shall be allowed to stay only from **24th August early morning to 27th August Evening**. Nodal Centre can claim reimbursement of this amount as per the criteria mentioned in **point B. However, no amount will be reimbursed to those evaluators who have been appointed by the Nodal Centre.**
- ✓ **Nodal Centre Heads:** Stay and food arrangements for MIC/AICTE officials (Nodal Centre Heads) will be arranged by the Nodal Centre and can be claimed post event on reimbursement basis.

IV. Honorarium for Juries/evaluators/experts:

- ✓ Honorarium of the Juries/evaluators/experts **appointed by the MIC/AICTE** have been taken care by the MIC/AICTE itself. Nodal centre have to collect the enclosed TA/Honorarium form of the Council which contains the personal information along with the bank account details and signed by the Juries/evaluators/experts and verified by the Nodal Centres along with the documentary proof i.e. the copy of cancelled cheque/bank passbook/account statement and PAN Card.
- ✓ No claim can be made against these expenses by the nodal centre. Nodal centre has to send these documents to AICTE/MIC with the utilization certificate and statement of expenditure, and the amount will be transferred directly to the evaluator's bank account post receiving the documents and satisfactory verification.
- ✓ However, no amount will be reimbursed/transferred to those evaluators, who have been appointed by the Nodal Centre.

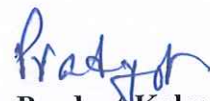
V. Expenses under Marketing & Outreach (On reimbursement basis):

- ✓ **Printing Dummy Cheques.** The cost towards printing of dummy cheques for the winning teams as the case may be, will be met under this head for which a maximum amount of Rs 500/- per problem statement is permissible.
- ✓ **Mementoes:** The cost towards purchasing mementoes and other goodies for all the participants, volunteers and other officials (Max 300 persons) will be met under this head for which a maximum amount of Rs 250/- per person is permissible.
- ✓ **Printing Certificate, Lanyards and Registration Kit etc:** The cost towards purchasing of printing certificates, Notepad, pen, information brochure, ID card and lanyard etc for all the participants, volunteers and other officials (Max 350 Persons) will be met under this head for which a maximum amount of Rs 150/- per person is permissible.

Utilization & Refund of Grant:

1. This sanction is issued in exercise of the power delegated to All India Council for Technical Education and MoE's Innovation Cell and other terms & conditions laid down for the purpose.

2. The sanctioned amount is debitible under the budget of MoE's Innovation Cell. A separate account should be maintained so that it would not be mixed with other funds.
3. The assets acquired wholly or substantially out of AICTE's grants shall not be disposed or encumbered or utilized for the purpose other than those for which the grant was sanctioned.
4. AICTE/MIC or its nominee shall have the right to check/verify the items procured under above said heads during the SIH-2022 event.
5. Nodal Centre needs to maintain the record of all original bills/TA forms/transaction proof/vouchers and invoices etc. and shall submit the same along with the detailed statement of expenditure under various heads to MIC/AICTE.
6. Each Nodal Centre will have to submit the Audited Utilisation Certificate (Govt. Institutes can submit unaudited UCs) and statement of expenditure along with supporting vouchers/bills of the expenditure within two months from the date of releasing of funds.
7. The above sanction is subject to adjustment in future of any excess/less payment made based on the actual numbers of teams/participants, if found after auditing by internal audit team of MIC/AICTE.
8. Procurement of goods and services shall be made through a purchase committee which shall certify the reasonability and quality of the goods and services procured and shall be in accordance to the provisions contained in GFR-2017.
9. The unutilised and undisbursed amount shall be returned in the form of Demand Draft payable in favour of Innovation Cell Account, New Delhi along with all original documents.
10. The actual expenditure made under the above **Point B(1-4)** within the permissible limit will be allowed to settle post event based on production of actual bills along with Utilisation certificate and satisfactory verification from MIC/AICTE.
11. The amount sanctioned and expenditure incurred under one Head of Account may not be re-appropriated/exceed the budget amount and may not be utilized with other Head of Account.

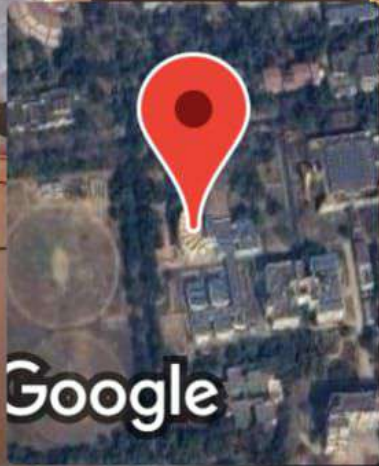

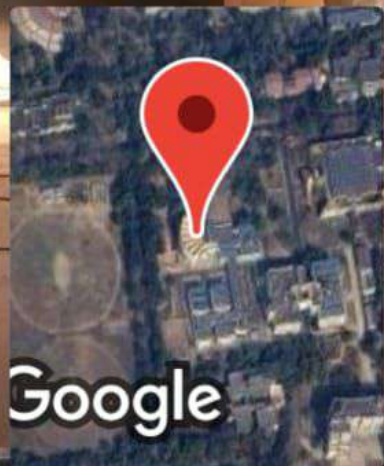
