

Further discussions and course of actions to be decided for implementation of the features of NEP-2020. In the next IQAC meeting a roadmap will be suggested for approval. IQAC coordinator has suggested if some seminars / workshops may be organized for some non NAAC accredited institutes to update them about the process of accreditation and its importance. The planning for such activity is to be done through the public relations department of the institute
