IQAC noted that to upgrade the technical skills of the students with the latest technologies in academics and industry with exposure to various hands-on exercises and to make them job ready for Campus Placement, a Memorandum Of Understanding (MOU) with Ardent Computech Pvt. Ltd., Kolkata was signed on 16<sup>th</sup> November, 2019 to expose students to the Emerging and Frontier Technologies – Internet of Things, Cloud Computing, Machine Learning etc.

The IQAC team highlighted that BCREC is fortunate enough to welcome the presence of eminent personalities both from India and abroad as invitee in the College Campus.
