Agenda Item No. 1/1: Introduction of Students' Council Members

Prof. (Dr.) Narendra Nath Pathak, Chairperson of Students' Council chaired the meeting. He welcomed all the Faculty Advisors and the students in the first meeting of the Council.

Agenda Item No. 1/2: Rationale behind Students' Council's formation

Prof. (Dr.) Narendra Nath Pathak, Chairperson of Students' Council delivered a brief introduction regarding the rationale behind the formation of **Students' Council**. He informed that the authorities of the college decided that students' scattered representation in various activities of the college is to be formalized for the overall interest of the college. He emphasized that the primary task of the Council will be to give students an opportunity to develop **leadership** by organizing and carrying out various activities of the college and **planning** recreational events that matches with the college spirit. He advised further that Students' Council will be a platform where students will share their ideas, interests and concerns with their teachers and administrative authorities for the betterment of their own college. Agenda Item No. 1/3: Structure of Students' Council

Agenda Item No. 1/7: Miscellaneous matters with permission of the Chair



Agenda Item No. 2/1: Pre-placement training for final and pre-final year students

Chairperson initiated the discussion on pre-placement training being imparted on Mock Aptitude Test, Mock GD and PI sessions which are held on continuous basis to achieve higher rate of placement. Prof. Rajdeep Ray, faculty advisor, informed that Professional Training Program will be provided by Co-cubes, Reference Globe and Placement Season for all the final year students of 2020. It was decided that Students' Council will take an active role to counsel all the final and pre-final year students to sit for the tests being taken by the external agencies. Both Chairperson and the faculty advisors advised the Council members to counsel the students to attend the Communication Skill classes seriously as many jobs require the communication skill.

Agenda Item No. 2/2: On-line Class Tests of theoretical papers

Chairperson further informed that as decided in HoDs' meeting, from this semester On-line class test will be introduced and will be conducted through in-house developed software, namely, the **Online Examination System (OES).** The first on-line class test will be held from 5/3/2019 to 9/3/2019. Students' Council through its members should make the students understand about the benefits of online class tests.

Agenda Item No. 2/3: Outcome based teaching-learning process

It was further discussed that since college is applying for NBA and NAAC accreditations, outcome-based teaching-learning process is to be followed in the college. Numerous Student-centric methods are also to be followed to enhance the Teaching-Learning process including class presentation by students, Class Assignments, Lab Experiments, Technical Videos/Case Studies, NPTEL and SWAYAM videos, IIT-Bombay Spoken Tutorial Projects etc. It was decided that Students' Council will demonstrate the usefulness of above methods and encourage the students to register for NPTEL courses and courses led by IIT-Bombay Spoken Tutorial Projects etc.

Agenda Item No. 2/4: Participation of Students' Council in NSS activities

It was informed that the Students' Council and the Student NSS team took an active part in the Organ-Donation Sensitization and Awareness Campaign for the Engineering and Management students on 19th January 2019.

Another noble drive for the community was the Voluntary Blood Donation Camp held on 25th January, 2019 hosted by the Students' Council and the NSS team. Agenda Item No. 3/3: Certification program on "Modern International Digital Marketing Tools and Practices"

Students' Council appreciated the college initiative for conducting one day certification program on "Modern International Digital Marketing Tools and Practices" on 19th March, 2019 partnered by The Cambridge Marketing Services, UK. Students' Council informed that the above event which highlighted the types, processes, tools and strategies of Digital Marketing in today's market was quite beneficial for the students.

Agenda Item No. 3/4: Student Chapter activities

Students' Chapter activities were discussed and the members of Students' Council informed that during March to May, 2019 student chapter of the college in association with IEEE student branch of Durgapur organized three workshops, viz. (i) "Google Cloud Study – JAM", (ii) "Blockchain" and (iii) "Basics of Python". The above three workshops helped the students to get exposure to hands-on exercises and an insight on the recent applications by the Industry stalwarts. Agenda Item No. 3/6: Continuous Evaluation (CA) Process of MAKAUT

Chairperson mentioned that at all meetings of Departmental Academic Committees (DACs) the new process of Continuous Assessments (CAs) viz. 4(four) times in a semester based on Class Tests (online/off-line) has already been discussed. Accordingly, all the students will be assessed at the end of August, September, October and November 2019 as per Academic Calendar published by the University and the College. It is to be noted that every time, i.e. 4 times, the marks of the class test should be converted to 25 during submission of the marks in the portal. It was discussed and decided that the Students' Council members should make all the students aware about this new assessment process.

Agenda Item No. 3/7: MOOCs Course to earn credit marks for securing B.Tech (Hons)

Students' Council noted that first year students appeared for one of the MOOCs courses provided by NPTEL, "**Developing Soft Skills and Personality**" which was of 3 credits. 1st year students of 2018-19 who had cleared the above NPTEL course will be awarded marks on account of MOOCs credits i.e. under additional 20 credits for acquiring the degree of B.Tech with Honours, effective from the session of 2018-19. They assured that this information will be percolated to the first year students
